Inter-Generational Sewing Project: Pillowcase Dresses

List of Items to Bring:

The following items make one dress.

(Please bring material for at least one dress and more if you like).

Base materials:

- 5/8-1 ¼ yd x 42" 100% cotton material
Plus contrasting 100% cotton material sized: ½ yr. X 42"
- OR new or slightly used standard pillow cases (patterns and colors appealing to young girls preferred)

(All material / pillowcases should be washed in hot water and ironed)

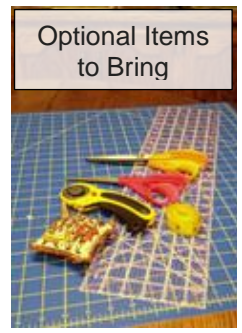
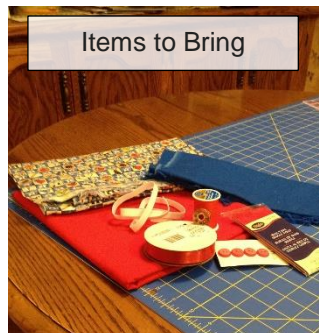
Finishing Materials:

- 4 yds extra wide double fold bias tape
- 6-17" ¼" wide elastic
- Thread:
- Rick rack, ribbon, buttons for decoration only (optional)
- Extra "scraps" to share with others if you have any to donate.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine/s if you are willing to share them.
- Sewing tools to make the dresses such as cutting boards, scissors, pinking shears, seam gauge, pins, electrical cords, etc.
